INFORMATION

EXPERIENCE OF THE TRIP

This is a trip designed to enrich the participants with an authentic African cultural experience. It is our hope that this trip will shed off many African cultural stereotypes that have painted Africa negatively. While you are having fun, you will be learning a great deal from real experience, especially from the most original museum of archaeology and the majestic Flora and Fauna. At the coast you will see the very rich history, and learn how the Arabs and the Portuguese influenced the East African coast as colonialist before the British and the Germans. Ensure that you bring good photo and video cameras to capture this experience!

THE KENYA COAST

The Kenyan coast has four regions. Apart from the town, and part of Mombasa, there is, the south coast, which stretches from Mombasa to the Tanzania border, and the north coast covering the beaches from Mombasa to Kilifi, Malindi and Watamu. Each of these areas has regular visitors, some returning year after year.

WHAT TO EXPECT IN KENYA

Expect to get a once in a lifetime experience. Kenya has a unique combination of wildlife sanctuaries, beautiful beaches, breathtaking sceneries, comfortable climate and luxurious accommodations accompanied by a hospitable and happy people. There are very few places on earth with such abundance and diversity in attractions.

WEATHER

June and July are the coolest months and are often overcast, especially in the mornings. Visitors should not be discouraged from going on a safari in the rainy season.

DRESS

A safari suit is the ideal dress for both sexes while on safari. In the highland areas (Nairobi), it can be quite cool at night and in the early morning. Some warm clothing is essential such as a warm sweater or heavy sweatshirt.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1) A visa & a valid passport are required.
- 2) Credit cards are recommended. ATM machines are available to obtain Kenya shillings.

MEDICAL INFORMATION - HEALTH TIPS

- Tour participants can be covered by flying doctors insurance for evacuation purposes at an extra cost of USD \$20 per person.
- All of the major towns have good hospitals. Specialists can be found in Nairobi and Mombasa.
- Insurance for inpatient services is provided at an extra cost of USD \$270 per person, if needed.

IMMUNIZATION

Currently certificates of inoculation against yellow fever and cholera are not required except from countries where those diseases are being experienced. Anti- malaria tablets should be taken two weeks before departure, during and two weeks after the visit. Insect repellent will be necessary to avoid insect bites where possible. Please consult your doctor for prescriptions.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Travel insurance is strongly recommended to be protected from any losses or travel delays. This insurance is not provided, nor is it included in the cost of the 2006 Kenya Life Time Tour. The following insurance company information is provided:

TIPS

Tippping at hotels is necessary as an appreciation, (suggestion - 10% of the total bill). It is customary to tip safari driver guides. Tippping depends on the quality of service.

LAUNDRY

A safari suit costs from \$3.00 - \$4.00, and a shirt costs from \$1.00 - \$2.00 per day, to clean.

SHOPPING

Large supermarkets have all the items you might need in both Nairobi and Mombasa. You will find large stores with a variety of products including carvings and paintings, and all the souvenirs you can imagine.

TOUR COST

The total cost for the trip is USD \$4,000.00 – double occupancy
\$5,100.00 – single occupancy
\$3,400.00 – minors lodging with parent or guardian
